**RULE 4082  
EXPUNGEMENT**

- (a) All petitions for dismissal pursuant to Penal Code sections 1203.4 or 1203.4a must be served on the District Attorney. Proof of service must be filed with the clerk's office at the time the petition is filed.
- (b) **[If it has been more than ten (10) years from the date of disposition of the case, or five (5) years in the case of a misdemeanor, or the case has been destroyed pursuant to Government Code sections 68152 and 68153, the petitioner must provide evidence to support the claim for relief, along with the petition. This subdivision shall not be construed to relieve the petitioner of any other obligation to provide supporting evidence that may exist.]** ~~If the case has been destroyed pursuant to statute (see Government Code sections 68152 and 68153) or is more than 10 years from the date of disposition, the defendant must, along with the petition, provide a copy of the probation order or his or her criminal history record.
