
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

By order of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Riverside County, except as provided for in California Rule of Court, Rule 1.150, and except for photographing and recording adoption hearings by persons permitted to be present at the hearing, court proceedings shall not be photographed, recorded, videotaped, or broadcast for private or commercial purposes. This includes all media outlets. This order applies to courtrooms, courthouses (including all hallways, offices and lobby areas), and courthouse entrances and exits. All persons interested in photographing, recording, or broadcasting court proceedings must request an order from the judge assigned to the proceeding in advance as required by California Rule of Court, Rule 1.150 and Local Rule 10030.

1 Requests to take photographs of non-confidential hard copy or online court
2 documents with a private camera will be permitted, at no cost to the user, as long as such
3 activity does not violate any statutory provisions or disrupt public service.
