Document Preparation Clinic

* This clinic is open only to low-income individuals who live in Riverside County.

“I won...how do I collect the judgment?”

“I lost...how can I appeal? Can the Petitioner collect from my wages? How can I stop them?”

During this session, you will meet with an attorney trained in small claims matters, and discuss the next steps you can take to collect your judgment, appeal the ruling, or file an exemption to wage garnishment. The attorney will prepare the legal documents for you to file, but you will continue to represent yourself in the case.
