

SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

The Court adopts the following Emergency Rule, which is intended to address the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, under the authority granted the Court by the March 23, 2020 order of the Chief Justice of California as Chair of the Judicial Council of California. This rule is effective July 1, 2020.

Emergency Local Rule 2 – Amendment to Local Rule 4070 – Extensions of Minor Offense Violations

Local Rule 4070 is amended to read:

Upon the oral or written request of the defendant, a one-time 90-day extension from the original date to appear shall be granted by the Clerk’s Office on violations processed in the Minor Offense Divisions. To request an extension beyond 90 days from the original appearance date, the defendant must submit a written request to the court for review by a judicial officer. The written request may be submitted via eSubmit, mail, or email.
