RIVERSIDE COUNTY:

On January 29, 2024, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Scott Williams to a vacant judgeship in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside.

Scott P. Williams, of Orange County, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the Riverside County Superior Court. Williams has served as a Deputy District Attorney at the Riverside County District Attorney's Office since 2007. He earned a Juris Doctor degree from Whittier Law School. Williams fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Craig G. Riemer.

A state Judicial Needs Assessment has found that the Riverside Superior Court is in dire need of judgeships to help process the growing caseloads in its communities. The filling of this vacancy by Scott Williams will greatly assist the Court's goal in continuing to provide access to justice for court litigants.
