RIVERSIDE COUNTY:

On September 18, 2025, Governor Gavin Newsom announced the appointment of Sylwia Luttrell and Amy Nett to vacant judgeships in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside.

Sylwia Luttrell, of Riverside County, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the Riverside County Superior Court. Luttrell has served as a Commissioner at the Riverside Court since 2024. She worked as a Hearing Officer at the Riverside Court from 2021 to 2024. She served as a Deputy District Attorney at the Riverside County District Attorney's Office from 2010 to 2021. Luttrell received a Master of Law degree from the University of San Diego School of Law. She fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Bernard J. Schwartz.

Amy K. Nett, of Riverside County, has been appointed to serve as a Judge in the Riverside County Superior Court. Nett has served as a Probate Attorney at the Los Angeles County Superior Court since 2024. She worked as a Partner at the Law Offices of Nett & Nett from 2002 to 2024. She was a Professor at the University of Phoenix from 2013 to 2019. She was an Associate at Rosenstein & Southwick from 2001 to 2002. Nett received a Juris Doctor degree from California Western School of Law. She fills the vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Angel M. Bermudez.

A state Judicial Needs Assessment has found that the Riverside Superior Court is in dire need of judgeships to help process the growing caseloads in its communities. The filling of these vacancies by Sylwia Luttrell and Amy Nett will greatly assist the Court's goal in continuing to provide access to justice for court litigants.
