**GENERAL ORDER NO.: 2022-30
FORTY-SECOND IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-38-20, and the September 2, 2022 Order of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the August 31, 2022 renewed request for an emergency order made by Presiding Judge John Monterosso of the Superior Court of Riverside County (Court), this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

In cases in which the original or previously extended statutory deadline otherwise would expire from September 7, 2022, to October 7, 2022, inclusive, any judge of the Court may extend the time period provided in section 1382 of the Penal Code for the holding of a criminal trial by not more than 30 days, (Gov. Code, § 68115(a)(10); Executive Order N-38-20 (03-27-20).)

The Court reserves the authority to rescind or modify this order, as appropriate, to address changing circumstances.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
